During her time with the JLP, Linda served on the Board and was actively involved with the Oregon State Public Affairs Committee. As a Sustainer she has mentored active members on fundraising topics; such as, grant writing.

Linda has always been an advocate for those in our community that need additional assistance to reach their own sustainability. She is very social service minded and you will see that reflected in her many years of service that followed her active years in the Junior League.

Some of the many roles which Linda has taken on include

- ◆ Letty Owings Center Fundraiser– where mothers are treated for drug addiction and alcoholism and also begin learning essential life skills.
- ◆ Wallace Medical Concern Fundraiser– providing affordable primary and urgent medical services for thousands of Portland and Gresham residents who have no insurance or face other barriers to care.

Community Development

Between the Lines

Between the Lines promotes literacy and strengthens family bonds between incarcerated and deployed military parents and their children. Parents choose a book for their child and a Junior League volunteer makes a recording of the parent reading the book aloud. The recorded reading in CD-format, along with a new, gift-wrapped book, is then sent to the child to read along with their parent while separated.



This national program, launched by the Junior League of Portland, allows children to hear their parent's voice at any time. Additionally, listening to the recordings while following along in the books provided by Between the Lines enhances early reading skills.

The Junior League of Portland has also expanded Between the Lines to support a continued connection between children and their parents who are deployed by the National Guard.

During 2013-2014, 171 children and 100 parents benefitted from Between the Lines through four readings

Healthy Habits, Healthy Kids

Healthy Habits, Healthy Kids is a Junior League of Portland program dedicated to supporting lifelong healthy living for Portland area children and their families.

JLP once again partnered with Multnomah and Washington County 4-H at their Christmas in Dairyville at Alpenrose Dairy to provide Portland area families with information on healthy living and habits.

2013-2014 Programs

Stop Human Trafficking

The Stop Human Trafficking program exists to effectively engage in anti-trafficking efforts. The focus is on spreading awareness, advocating for survivors, and community collaboration. Together with the community, JLP strives to shed light on domestic human trafficking and the commercial sexual exploitation of children.



Through funding from the JLP's Endowment Fund and a grant from La Salle Preparatory School, JLP produced a documentary, *Waiting for the Light: Portland's Sex Trafficking Crisis*, which focuses on child sex trafficking in Portland, OR. This film

was released in January 2014 and has since been viewed over 8,850 times by numerous Portland area residents and groups. The Mission Theater screening had over 300 attendees.

During the 2nd Annual Delicates Drive , 1,546 undergarments were donated and \$1,115 was raised. Often times, the survivors' undergarments are taken as evidence when they are first rescued. The local organizations who provide immediate and long term care do not have the capability to supply survivors of human trafficking with these essential items.

Volunteer In Portland (VIP)

In addition to Junior League of Portland initiatives and programs, Volunteer in Portland provides single-day volunteer assistance to nonprofit organizations in the Portland metropolitan area.

League members use their skills and experience to enhance the work of our community partners. These collaborative relationships benefit families in the greater Portland area while offering meaningful volunteer opportunities for our members.

During 2013-2014, JLP partnered with Peninsula Children's Learning Center, Children's Relief Nursery, The Children's Book Bank, Raphael House, Girls, Inc., and Bradley Angle.

Leadership Development

As members of the Portland metro community, we are inextricably linked to those around us and care deeply about the issues in our backyard. By preparing local women for a lifetime of civic leadership, we ensure that women will be ready and able to affect positive change for years to come, regardless of the issues tomorrow brings. As a result, our members - known for their competence, eloquence, and passion - are coveted by other non-profit boards and organizations for their dedication and leadership skills.

Our timely, relevant, and engaging trainings enhance the personal and professional development of JLP members and equip her to fulfill a variety of roles within and beyond the organization. Most topics focus on transferrable skills, customized to the unique needs of JLP Members and facilitated by professional facilitators, industry experts, and corporate trainers. JLP Trainings are a complimentary service for all JLP Members.

Training topics include Cultural Competency, Public Speaking, Non-Violent Communication, Entertaining & Networking, Financial Planning & Budgeting, Personal Style, Mindful Leadership, Team Building & Management, Organizing, Advocacy, and Fund Development.

All JLP Members are leaders in the community, regardless of their role within JLP. Our Annual Leadership Summit, open to all JLP members and held each spring, is an all-day retreat experience focused on your development as a leader.

JLP members may attend AJLI conferences to develop skills and expertise necessary for their roles within JLP. Members attending conferences have attended sessions on membership recruitment and retention, re-engaging Sustainers, issue-based community impact, social media, leadership styles, financial and fundraising topics.

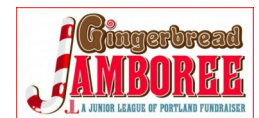
