The Junior League of Portland, (JLP) is the 4th oldest League in the world and part of an international membership of more than 155,000 women dedicated to civic leadership and community impact. The Impact of the Junior League of Portland

The following programs are designed and operated by our volunteer Members to address our community's most urgent needs

Between the Lines

Between the Lines promotes literacy and strengthens family bonds between incarcerated or deployed parents and their children. Junior League volunteers record parents reading aloud and then provide a CD or DVD of the recording with a new copy of the book to the child. This national program, designed and implemented by the Junior League of Portland, allows children to hear their parent's voice at any time during periods of extended separation and enhances early reading skills. With six reading sessions per year, the Junior League of Portland reaches approximately 300 children annually.

Healthy Habits, Healthy Kids

Healthy Habits, Healthy Kids is a JLP program dedicated to supporting lifelong healthy living for Portland area children and their families. The Junior League of Portland partnered with Multnomah and Washington County 4-H to establish annual Wellness Fairs and special events supporting healthy lifestyle habits at local Portland area elementary schools. Activities typically include a family bike ride, bike safety, arts, crafts, a petting zoo, science exhibits, gardening, food demonstrations, music and much more.

Volunteer in Portland

Volunteer in Portland provides single-day volunteer assistance to six nonprofits in Portland who share our dedication to the youngest of Portland's citizens. Junior League of Portland's VIP partners include:

Stop Human Trafficking Committee

The Junior League of Portland's Stop Human Trafficking Committee raises awareness, advocates for survivors, and launched a collective impact approach to addressing one of our community's most troubling and urgent issues. Together with the community and a network of expert advisors, we're working to shed light on domestic human trafficking and the commercial sexual exploitation of children. Through a grant from our endowment fund and a grant from La Salle Preparatory School, JLP made a documentary, *Waiting for the Light: Portland's Sex Trafficking Crisis*, about child sex trafficking in Portland, OR. Our annual Delicates Drive also raises awareness and provides much needed items for survivors.
